EduCampus is continuing to roll out this solution across all of it's SRMS clients.

elnvoicing

EduCampus have completed all phases of the project to provide an elnvoicing shared-service solution to it's FMS client community. This solution not only ensures compliance with the European Standard (EN) but also delivers a fully automated integration into each clients' Financial Management System. It also facilitates the automatic transfer of structured data received in eDocument form, from third parties to the client's data processing environment (Unit4 ERP). In addition, the implementation of the Incoming Invoices module has improved the processes for registration and processing of both elnvoices and emailed invoices across the sector. 
